Pt 3: Character Guardrails

- **Observation # 1:** We expect and value good character in those whom we associate with, work with and live with.
- **Observation # 2:** We are disappointed in those same people when they display a lack of character and don't live up to **our** expectations.
- **Problem # 1:** Irresponsibility is easily seen in others, but my irresponsibility is hard for me to see in the mirror!
- **Problem # 2:** Our society promotes achievement and ambition over good character and integrity.
 - Society rewards achievement!
 God rewards character before achievement!
 - When we choose achievement and ambition over character and integrity, the key area of our lives that suffers the most, is our relationships.

Character is the oil of relationships!

- Extract the oil of character from any relationship, regardless of how perfectly the two people are suited, and eventually there will be dysfunction or a total breakdown.
- People that were designed for each other, minus the oil of character, destroy one another!
- **Definition of Godly Character**: "Godly character is the will to do what is right as God defines right, regardless of the cost!"
- God desires us to do what is right because it honours and pleases Him.
 - **Proverbs 11:1-3** (net) The Lord abhors (loathes, detests, despises) dishonest scales...
- The idea behind this word "abhors" in the original Hebrew writing is a 'gut wrenching hatred' for dishonest scales.
- There is something in us that attracts us to dishonesty especially when it benefits us.
- God dislikes anyone who acts dishonestly at the expense of somebody else.
 - 1: The Lord abhors dishonest scales an accurate weight is His delight.

God delights in our honesty.

2: When pride comes, then comes disgrace, (there are always negative consequences to pride) but with humility comes wisdom.

God rewards humility with wisdom.

- Humility is viewing ourselves and our achievements through the lens of who God is in our lives.
- As a follower of Christ our goal is to please God with our life.
 - 3: The integrity (The quality of being honest and having strong moral principles, moral uprightness the state of being whole and undivided words and actions are the same.) of the upright guides them...
- God's will is found in the pursuit of Godly character and integrity by simply doing what is right in God's eyes!
- Once our inner world is solid and secure, generally our outer world will take care of itself!
 - *3:* ...but the unfaithful are destroyed by their duplicity.

People suffer the consequences of not pursuing Godly character.

- *Proverbs 11:1-3* declares that God desires a better life for those who are suffering the consequences of not pursuing Godly character.
- God responds to us in three ways when we pursue godly character over achievement, accomplishment, pleasure and fulfilment;
 - 1. He will delight in us when we are honest.
 - 2. He will give us wisdom when we are humble.
 - 3. He will guide us as we pursue integrity of character.

Jesus models the character that God wants in us.

Romans 8:29a (nlt) For God knew His people in advance, and He chose them to become like His Son...

- The character of Jesus is not something we can manufacture but it is something that is produced in and through us.
- As we allow Jesus to live through us, our character will reflect His!
- This transformation is a life-long process through an intimate and lifegiving relationship with Jesus.
 - **2** Corinthians 5:17 (mev) Therefore, if any man is in Christ, he is a new creature. Old things have passed away. Look, all things have become new.
- "Lord, give me the wisdom to know what is right, and the courage to do what is right, no matter what!"
