

Hearing God's Voice

Proposition 1. If I hear God's voice & respond to God's voice, then I will walk in blessing and prosperity.

The challenge before all of us is to do it consistently and not give up (HEAR & APPLY. James 1:22). In spite of circumstances Phil 4:11. Content.

Proposition 2. At any given time, my life is a reflection of how I have applied God's Word or lack of application. Gal 6:7-9.

Proposition 3. God's Word is full of wisdom to walk in. Seek it and you will find it, walk in it for success. Deut 30:19.

A few examples. 2 Tim 3:16. Our source of Wisdom.

Samuel. 1 Sam 3: A novice. He had to learn how to hear God's voice. He had to be taught. So do we. We all need teachers. Eli was Samuel,s teacher. Ken Chant was mine. Who is yours?

V7. The Word of the Lord had not yet been revealed to Samuel. V10. Speak for your servant is listening (Serve & learn).

V21. God revealed himself to Samuel through the Word.

My opinion. *If you don't know the Word, you can't know God.* Ken Chant's influence in my life and ministry.

Moses. Past disappointment ruined his confidence with God. Exodus 4:13. Please send someone else, I can't speak or think. Like Moses we all have traumatic experiences that block faith.

We have to learn to trust God in spite of our inadequacies.

We grow as we go, step by step, day by day.
One day in the Solomons. Growing as we are
going.

Moses presented God's commandments and
laws to Israel. God can do great things
through us like Moses, if we prevail.

Gideon. External social pressures &
circumstances.

Jud 6:12. Greetings mighty warrior. Gideon
doubted God's Words. He doubted his own
ability, doubted he could be of use
to God. What happens around us often
destroys faith in God. James 1:6. He who
doubts is like a wave.

Key Scripture.

**2 Peter 1:3-11. His divine power has given us
all we need for life & Godliness, so we may
participate in the divine nature
& escape the corruption of this world. For
this reason....**

Conclusion.

There are many obstacles to overcome before we can walk in blessing and prosperity. But a promise was given by God in **Joshua 1:8-9**.

Matthew 4:4. Feed yourself on the Word. What's happening in our lives is a direct reflection of how we apply God's Word.

John 8:47. How much time do you devote to God's Word?

Amos 7:8. I am setting a plumb line among my people. How do you fair?

Psalms 139:23-24. Regular assessment (no fear).

Isaiah 30:21. Whether you turn left or right you will hear His voice. This is the way, walk in it.

So, how can we see more of God's blessing and prosperity. ***Become & continue as a student & servant of God's Word. Study & serve simultaneously. Apply & serve as you go. Allow God to help you overcome inadequacies and fears.***
