

# HE KNOWS

**Text: John 2:1-11.**

Jesus started his first year of ministry with a miracle.

It is quite interesting that amongst the many miracles that Jesus made, this miracle was the very first one.

I do believe that God has a purpose and God has designed it that way to teach us some valuable lessons as we begin our journey in this brand new year 2020.

The first miracle that Jesus made was during the wedding.

In His busy schedule, Jesus stopped and attended a wedding.

**God honours relationships – *right relationships*.**

Without a right relationship nothing great can be accomplished.

**In a relationship, there will always be a need. When a need arises, what do we do?**

**Here are the 5 key principles to live by...**

**1. Invite Jesus.**

*<sup>2</sup> Now both Jesus and His disciples were invited to the wedding.*

Jesus knows your need.

He is the 3<sup>rd</sup> strand in every relationship.

*Eccl. 3:12, A three-fold cord is not quickly broken (hard to break).*

In a relationship, **forgiveness must be your default position.**

And the **foundation** of every relationship must be **commitment and sacrifice rather than comfort and convenience.**

## **2. Trust in His timing.**

*<sup>4</sup> Jesus said to her, “Woman... My hour has not yet come.”*

He knows when you really need it.

Ecclesiastes... *“He makes beautiful in his time”.*

God ordains a time and a season for everything.

***A person who truly believes God also believes in His timing.***

With regard to our need, **God knows our needs.**

Sometimes we need to know **the time** and **the season.**

If it is not God’s ordained time and season nothing will happen.

## **3. Do whatever Jesus tells you to do.**

*<sup>5</sup> His mother said to the servants, “Whatever He says to you, do it.”*

He knows what He is doing.

No ifs, no buts, no whys, no questions asked. Just do it! Obedience is the greatest and highest form of love. Jesus said, *“If you love me, you will obey my words”*. Obedience is greater than sacrifice.

Don't try to bribe God with your giving, with your sacrifices.

God always requires a whole-hearted obedience on your part.

### **Isaiah 1:19**

*If you are willing and obedient, you will eat the good of the land.*

### **4. Fill yourself up.**

*<sup>7</sup> Jesus said to them, “Fill the water pots (jars, vessels) with water.” And they filled them up to the brim.*

Jesus knows how it works. He knows how it is done. God sees us as jars of clay or vessels and we always carry something.

*Friends, in reality, man as a vessel has never been emptied.*

There is always something or someone occupying this vessel.

The million-dollar question is, ***“What is filling this vessel?”***

What is in this vessel? What is filling you in? What is occupying you?

If there is something that we need to do to make this vessel a vessel for honour and a vessel fit for the master's use, we need to do these things...

*a. **Be filled with the Holy Spirit.***

Read *Eph. 5:18; Acts 2:4; Acts 13:52*

*b. **Fill your heart and mind with God's Word.***

Read *Phils. 4:8-9; John 17:17; John 14:3-4; Heb. 4:12*

## **5. Share it with others.**

*<sup>8</sup> And He said to them, "Draw some out now, and take it to the master of the feast." And they took it. He knows who needs it.*

This wine was rare and priceless and yet they were able to share it to others.

You have something that is priceless and precious that is worth sharing.

You never know what miracle it will create not until you share it to others.

Again, you have something in your life that people need.

You've got nothing to lose but so much to gain when you share it to others.

***Jesus knows all your need, trust Him.
