Genesis 1:27-29

In the beginning, there was lots of responsibility, but only one rule.

Genesis 2:15-17; 3:8-11

When people take responsibility for the things they are responsible for - beginning with themselves - they don't need many rules.

Genesis 3:12-13

Irresponsibility Creates Conflict in Others

- Irresponsibility that leads to blame always creates conflict.
- Where there is blame there is often shame and guilt.
- Every time we intentionally or unintentionally don't take responsibility, we create conflict somewhere with someone.
