

Topic: STRIKING THE ARROWS

Great Commission

Mark 16:15-16 "Go into all the world and preach the good news to all creation. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned."

2 Kings 13:14-20

In this story, Jehoash is the king of Israel who at the time was being threatened by the armies of Amaziah, the king of Judah.

How could Jehoash's future be affected by how many times he hit the arrows on the ground? Elisha instructed him to strike the ground, but he didn't say how many times.

Elisha began with a promise of a complete victory "That arrow is a sign that the Lord will help you completely defeat the Syrian army." But Jehoash would receive much less "... now you will defeat them only three times."

The difference between a complete victory and a partial victory was Jehoash's choice to strike the arrow only 3 times.

This revealed to Elisha that Jehoash lacked determination to receive the full measure of God's provision and intention for him.

What does the story have to do with our involvement in the Great Commission?

Elisha placed his hand on the king's hand...that arrow is a sign that the Lord will help you.

Many years ago, God called (shot) our church into planting churches around Australia and into the mission fields to fulfil the Great Commission.


"If you had struck it five or six times, you would completely wipe out the Syrians"

Our challenge is to not give up reaching new frontiers to extend God's Kingdom.


We should never stop striking the arrows of giving, sending and visiting!
