Quarantine – to prevent the spread of the disease

A **lockdown** is a requirement for people to stay where they are to eliminate the spread of the virus.

**Quarantine** and **lockdown** are both described by the word *isolation*.

God has a ways and means committee to rearrange the affairs of humanity to set our priorities right.

1 Cor. 15:19 - <sup>19</sup> If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men the most pitiable.

Mark 36-37 - <sup>36</sup> For what does it profit a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?

We can only have a glimpse of what God will do during and after this pandemic by looking into the BIBLE (**B**asic **I**nstructions **B**efore **L**eaving **E**arth).

Ex. **Jonah** was in total lockdown for 3 days and 3 nights in the belly of the whale.

While in lockdown, God changed his heart and with boldness Jonah preached at Nineveh and wrought one of history's greatest revival.

Some of the reasons why isolation is part of God's plan:

Isolation is a time of preparation

For Moses, David, Joseph and others, they used their time of isolation in the wilderness and in prison cells to prepare themselves for what

- Isolation is a time of insulation
   The Bible encourages us on how to protect ourselves.
  - a. Follow godly counsel *Psalm 1:1-6*
  - b. Not to conform to the patterns of the world *Romans* 12:2
  - c. Do not partner with those inconsistent with your faith -2 Corinthians 6:14
- Isolation is a time of decision
   The prodigal son was in isolation, far away from his family and true friends. During this time, he realised what matters most in life.
- Isolation is a time to remember God's love and His mighty deeds in the past

"And you shall remember the **Lord** your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day. **Deut. 8:18** 

## Jesus is our great example.

Jesus was placed in isolation and solitude. The Holy Spirit took Him in the wilderness for 40 days and 40 nights. His time of solitude was a time of preparation, a time insulation, a time of decision, a time to remind Himself of God's love and His

**Isaiah 9: 6-7** – <sup>6</sup> For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and **the government shall be upon his shoulder**: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

<sup>7</sup> Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

Only those under His government will experience true peace.

Peace is not the absence of fear and chaos but the **PRESENCE OF JESUS**.
