FUNDRAISING INITIATIVE: GIVE A COFFEE

Throughout 2020 Door of Hope Preschool in Vavuniya, Sri Lanka faced numerous closures due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Although the pandemic continues to affect daily life in Sri Lanka, our preschool is currently up and running with 12 students enrolled and two teachers.

During the challenging times caused by the pandemic, some of our supporters outside the church have had to decrease their support of Door of Hope Preschool. This means we require more funds per month to keep the preschool running.

With this in mind, we have decided to bring back our 'Give a Coffee' fundraising campaign. We ran this campaign a number of years ago to raise money for other areas of missions and it was very successful!

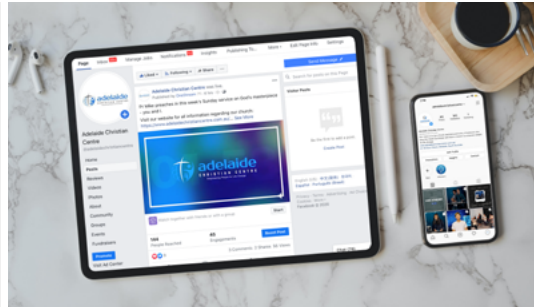
We are aiming at raising an additional \$700 per month to contribute to the ongoing running of the preschool, as well as a new playground.

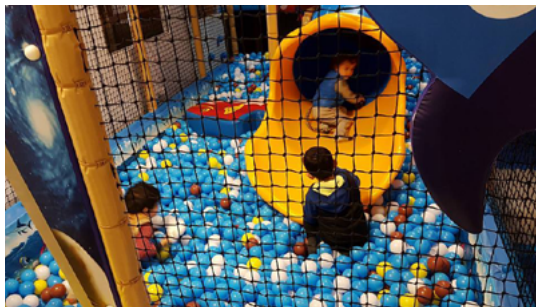

Saturday 10th April Ice Skating

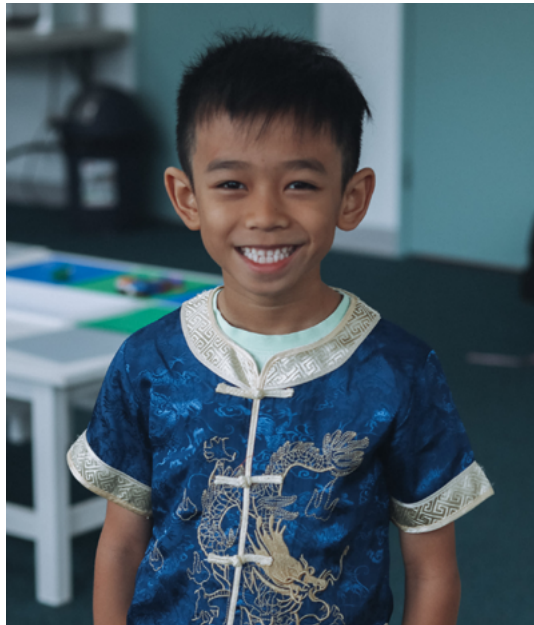

Vision Christian Radio Tennant Creek

Our story as a broadcaster in our own right began in 1999. 'Vision FM' was born on 1st February that year in Springwood, Brisbane. Mid 2001 we moved to a larger premises in Underwood to enable us to better provide 24/7 broadcast coverage to a growing number of relay stations across the nation, plus listeners on the internet.

In the 12 months following March 2001, an expansion began, with our relay stations tripling to around 90. In the same year, we introduced Australia's first nationwide Christian worldview news service – now heard on Vision and around 25 other stations.

In 2003 we had a chance to secure our first

high-powered licences. The network quickly reached 150 relay stations by the end of 2003, and in 2004, our first foray into AM radio followed with sites in Shepparton, Bunbury and Kalgoorlie. Prior to Christmas 2004, a further 17 high-powered licences were secured, going on air in 2005.

Over the years, we've been able to acquire hundreds of high and low-powered open narrowcast licenses to set up a national network of relay stations. Many places have benefited from our cost effective approach of using low-powered FM transmitters. The setup cost is very achievable for most communities and the ongoing cost is minimal due to low maintenance equipment with low power consumption - we even use solar power in some remote areas.

As our network has grown, our program content has also matured and developed. Our team of professional broadcast staff comes from many walks of life and media backgrounds, and are the daily voice of Vision Christian Radio all across Australia.

Welcome to our April edition of our connect group news.

Every one of us should continue to grow warmer through fellowship.

God never intended for us to walk alone. He created us to experience authentic community because life is better connected.

Authentic community occurs when we uphold the values and worth of each person, by creating an environment of love, acceptance and forgiveness.

We are in a world that is extremely isolated with the evolvement of technology and then most recently with the COVID-19 pandemic.

Unfortunately, we have lonely people around us.

One of God's purposes for our lives is to learn to relate and love people particularly our spiritual family – the church.

One of our responsibilities as a local church is to provide an opportunity for everyone to grow in their relationship with other believers.

Relationships are the glue of our church and in order for relationships to grow, we need time and communication.

Just attending a Sunday service is not enough to grow relationships. That is why we need small groups – connect groups.

People can develop meaningful relationships in connect groups.

Connect groups are the laboratory where we learn the valuable relational skills needed to become effective followers of Christ.

Connect groups provide an opportunity to hear, and be heard, about the things that God is speaking to us both personally and corporately as a group.

Consistency is a crucial factor for connect groups.

If people only attend connect groups when they feel like it, they will not develop meaningful relationships.

We need to be intentional, to make it a habit to be part of a connect group meeting.

Hebrews 10:24 tells us how important meeting together really is: *Let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds.*

If you are currently not a part of a connect group, I would highly recommend joining one today.

The growth that you have seen within yourself just from studying God's Word individually will grow substantially faster and stronger when you are involved in a connect group because 'life is better connected'.

OVERVIEW

Equip Training College (ETC) is intentional about equipping Christ followers to be effective ministers and leaders, who serve God by serving others.

Sri Lanka: ACC commits \$400 per month

Bethel Children's Homes have been in operation since 1998 when the first home opened with 11 girls. Since then two new homes have been built to house more girls on the same property. A property was also purchased to build a new home for boys. All of the children in the homes have been affected in some way by the war and civil unrest in Sri Lanka. This has resulted in them being displaced, physiologically affected and discriminated against.

The homes have government permission to care for up to 40 children. They maintain a family-like environment by ensuring a high level of individual care. The homes ensure all children are sent to primary and secondary schools within the community,

assures all medical and healthcare needs are met, provides all subsistence needs (i.e. food, clothing, shelter, water, sanitation, recreation etc.), and commits to continually support their overall physical, emotional, mental and intellectual development.

Our church provides financial and management support for the children and staff within the homes. As a church we sponsor four children - Angel, Thinu, Jonathan and George.

Prayer Points:

- Pray for all of our children during this uncertain time. Believe for all our new children to settle in effectively.
- Pray for our dedicated staff who take care of the children day-to-day, especially during this time with COVID-19.

Children's Feeding Programs

Philippines: ACC commits \$100 per month
