

FROM PR GREG

Feelings! Someone has said, 'feelings are good friends but terrible masters'. So true!

They are good friends in that they are sign posts indicating how our inner world is going.

We cannot ignore feelings but must address 'why' we feel the way we do, especially anxious or depressed feelings, and work to resolve issues we discover (perhaps with the help of others).

Yet, feelings are terrible masters if we allow them to rule us. Sometimes, if we give in to them they can lead us astray, or even lead us to act in self-destructive ways.

Feelings also may not be a true indicator of reality. For instance, when feeling depressed, we may think of our situations as hopeless or helpless. But is that true?

If I find my feelings getting the better of me, I go straight to the Word of God and I pray, "Lord speak to me today through your Word, for your Word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path" (Psalm 119:105).

I challenge any negative unbelieving thoughts and replace them with the

wonderful promises of God - and I speak them out over my life.

Another thing I do is pray in tongues for a while, sometimes a good while (1 Corinthians 14); and offer thanksgiving to God (1 Thessalonians 5:18).

I also may talk to trusted others about my feeling and thoughts to gain fresh perspectives.

These measures are not only therapeutic to my soul, but more importantly, enable me to fellowship with The One Who is 'my ever present Help' (Psalm 46:1).

In the fog of fuzzy emotions and feelings His light and leading, presence and power, cut through. I can then think more clearly and truthfully, my anxious thoughts and troubled feelings are soothed, and I am able to make objective, rather than subjective decisions. Then my feelings remain good friends and not my master.

I am really looking forward to June and all that God will do in and through our lives.

Vision Christian Radio Tennant Creek

Our story as a broadcaster in our own right began in 1999. 'Vision FM' was born on 1st February that year in Springwood, Brisbane. Mid 2001 we moved to a larger premises in Underwood to enable us to better provide 24/7 broadcast coverage to a growing number of relay stations across the nation, plus listeners on the internet.

In the 12 months following March 2001, an expansion began, with our relay stations tripling to around 90. In the same year, we introduced Australia's first nationwide Christian worldview news service – now heard on Vision and around 25 other stations.

In 2003 we had a chance to secure our first

high-powered licences. The network quickly reached 150 relay stations by the end of 2003, and in 2004, our first foray into AM radio followed with sites in Shepparton, Bunbury and Kalgoorlie. Prior to Christmas 2004, a further 17 high-powered licences were secured, going on air in 2005.

Over the years, we've been able to acquire hundreds of high and low-powered open narrowcast licenses to set up a national network of relay stations. Many places have benefited from our cost effective approach of using low-powered FM transmitters. The setup cost is very achievable for most communities and the ongoing cost in minimal due to low maintenance equipment with low power consumption - we even use solar power in some remote areas.

As our network has grown, our program content has also matured and developed. Our team of professional broadcast staff comes from many walks of life and media backgrounds, and are the daily voice of Vision Christian Radio all across Australia.

Bethel Children's Homes

Sri Lanka: ACC commits \$400 per month **Tax Deductible Project Code:** J982N

Bethel Children's Homes have been in operation since 1998 when the first home opened with 11 girls. Since then two new homes have been built to house more girls on the same property. A property was also purchased to build a new home for boys. All of the children in the homes have been affected in some way by the war and civil unrest in Sri Lanka. This has resulted in them being displaced, physiologically affected and discriminated against.

The homes have government permission to care for up to 40 children. They maintain a family-like environment by ensuring a high level of individual care. The homes ensure all children are sent to primary and secondary schools within the community,

assures all medical and healthcare needs are met, provides all subsistence needs (i.e. food, clothing, shelter, water, sanitation, recreation etc.), and commits to continually support their overall physical, emotional, mental and intellectual development.

Our church provides financial and management support for the children and staff within the homes. As a church we sponsor four children - Angel, Thinu, Jonathan and George.
