# A Light for my Journey

Psalm 119:105. Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

## Introduction to Psalm 119

- The author is unknown
- Longest passage in our Bible
- A clear message about the WORD

Theme: 'The practical use of the Word of God in the life of a believer'.

- Psalm 119 is Acrostic: 8 lines per section with 22 sections.
- Each section is headed by a letter of the Hebrew alphabet. Aleph, Beth, Gimel, etc...
- There are 22 letters in the Hebrew Alphabet. 8 lines by 22 letters is 176.
- The author includes a 'word' that describes 'God's Word' in every line, or verse except for 7 verses.

- These include: Law, Testimony, Precept, Statute, Command/commandment, Judgement, Word, Promise, Decree.
- It is a magnificent piece of literature!
- It was written in the absence of other 'scripture writings' yet embraces overall Biblical themes.

### 1. Blessed and Blameless

■ Aleph – vs: 1-8

Blessed are the undefiled in the way, who walk in the <u>law</u> of the Lord!

- <sup>2</sup> Blessed are those who keep His <u>testimonies</u>, Who seek Him with the whole heart!
- <sup>3</sup> They also do no iniquity; They walk in His ways.
- <sup>4</sup> You have <u>commanded</u> us to keep Your <u>precepts</u> diligently.
- <sup>5</sup> Oh, that my ways were directed To keep Your <u>statutes</u>!
- <sup>6</sup> Then I would not be ashamed, When I look into all Your <u>commandments</u>.
- <sup>7</sup> I will praise You with uprightness of heart, When I learn Your righteous <u>judgments</u>.

<sup>8</sup> I will keep Your <u>statutes</u>; Oh, do not forsake me utterly!

Lesson: We are blessed as we live according to His Word.

## 2. God is all we need

□ Heth – vs: 57-64

<sup>57</sup> You are my portion, O Lord; I have said that I would keep Your <u>words</u>. <sup>58</sup> I entreated Your favor with my whole heart; Be merciful to me according to Your <u>word</u>. <sup>59</sup> I thought about my ways, And turned my feet to Your <u>testimonies</u>. <sup>60</sup> I made haste, and did not delay to keep Your **commandments**.

<sup>61</sup> The cords of the wicked have bound me, But I have not forgotten Your <u>law</u>. <sup>62</sup> At midnight I will rise to give thanks to You, Because of Your righteous <u>judgments</u>. <sup>63</sup> I am a companion of all who fear You, And of those who keep Your <u>precepts</u>. <sup>64</sup> The earth, O Lord, is full of Your mercy; Teach me Your **statutes**.

# 3. Read the manufacturers instructions

□ Yodh – vs: 73-80

<sup>73</sup> Your hands have made me and fashioned me; Give me understanding, that I may learn Your <u>commandments</u>.

<sup>74</sup> Those who fear You will be glad when they see me, Because I have hoped in Your word.

75 I know, O Lord, that Your

**judgments** are right,

And that in faithfulness You have afflicted me.

<sup>76</sup>Let, I pray, Your merciful kindness be for my comfort,

According to Your word to Your servant.

<sup>77</sup>Let Your tender mercies come to me, that I may live; For Your <u>law</u> is my delight.

<sup>78</sup> Let the proud be ashamed,

For they treated me wrongfully with falsehood;

But I will meditate on Your precepts.

<sup>79</sup>Let those who fear You turn to me,

Those who know Your testimonies.

<sup>80</sup> Let my heart be blameless regarding Your **statutes**, that I may not be ashamed.

### 4. Strength for the journey

□ Resh – vs: 153-160

<sup>153</sup> Consider my affliction and deliver me, For I do not forget Your law. 154 Plead my cause and redeem me; Revive me according to Your word. <sup>155</sup>Salvation is far from the wicked, For they do not seek Your statutes. <sup>156</sup> Great are Your tender mercies, O Lord; Revive me according to Your judgments. <sup>157</sup>Many are my persecutors and my enemies, Yet I do not turn from Your testimonies. <sup>158</sup>I see the treacherous, and am disgusted, Because they do not keep Your word. <sup>159</sup>Consider how I love Your **precepts**; Revive me, O Lord, according to Your lovingkindness. <sup>160</sup> The entirety of Your word is truth,

And every one of Your righteous <u>judgments</u> endures forever.

### Let the scripture speak...
