Education is a fundamental human right and is one of the most crucial factors influencing an individual's ability to develop to their full potential in life.

Access to and completion of an adequate education provides numerous opportunities for individuals, families and whole communities.

One of the most effective ways to empower men, women and children in Papua New Guinea to reach their full potential in life is through education.

Bethel International Training College (BITC) is our main training base in Papua New Guinea (PNG).

A range of courses are included within BITC, including Bethel Bible College, World Missions Faith Training School, Bethel Preschool Teacher Training and various others.

We are working in partnership with Global Development Group (GDG) to raise funds for BITC. This partnership provides our project with tax deductiblity for all donations made via GDG.

The major objective of this project is:

To have a fully functioning educational facility that will empower men, women and children through the provision of early childhood education and vocational training.

There are three main goals in this project.

GOAL ONE

Construct an educational facility that will be used for a preschool and vocational training.

The outcome of this goal is to have a fully functioning educational facility that is equipped with furniture and resources needed to run a preschool and vocational training.

GOAL TWO

Empower men and women through the provision of vocational training courses.

The outcome of this goal is that men and women are provided with an opportunity to gain valuable training that will increase their employability and improve their livelihoods.

GOAL THREE

Empower children through the provision of early childhood education.

The outcome of this goal is that by accessing quality preschool education, children are better prepared for primary school and are more likely to reach higher educational outcomes.







MISSIONS GIVING

Bethel Children's Homes TCCFC commits \$200 per month

Bethel Children's Homes have been in operation since 1998. All of the children have been affected by the war and unrest in Sri Lanka: displaced, physiologically affected, discriminated against.

The homes ensure all children are sent to primary and secondary schools within the community, assures all medical and healthcare needs are met, provides all subsistence needs (i.e. food, clothing, shelter, water, sanitation, recreation etc.), and commits to continually support their overall physical, emotional, mental and intellectual development.

TCCFC sponsors two children within the home, one boy (Nithusan) and one girl (Saruja). Both children are pictured above.

Door of Hope Preschool TCCFC commits \$100 per month

Door of Hope Preschool is located in Vavuniya in the north of Sri Lanka. It is predominantly made up of Tamil speaking children.

Our homes have been in operation since 1998 when the first home opened with 11 girls. Since then two new homes have been built to house more girls on the same property. A property was also purchased to build a new home for boys. All of the children in the homes have been affected in some way by the war and civil unrest in Sri Lanka: displaced, physiologically affected, discriminated against.

The homes have government permission to care for up to 40 children. They maintain a family-like environment by ensuring a high level of individual care. The homes ensure all children are sent to primary and secondary schools within the community,

assures all medical and healthcare needs are met, provides all subsistence needs (i.e. food, clothing, shelter, water, sanitation, recreation etc.), and commits to continually support their overall physical, emotional, mental and intellectual development.

ACC and TCCFC provides financial and management support for the children and staff within the homes. ACC sponsors four children - Angel, Thinu, Jonathan and George. TCCFC sponsors two children - Saruja and Nithusan.

SRI LANKA CHILDREN'S HOME UPDATE

After talking with Pr Somanathan in recent times, he has let us know that the overall situation in Sri Lanka is very concerning at the moment. The nation has also been going in and out of lockdown since the COVID-19 pandemic began.

Many people are heading to starvation due to the very bad management of the economy by the authorities. There are minimal imports due to inflation and there are no US dollars in the central bank or in the market. The price of goods has sky rocketed because of this as well.

There is limited sugar, powdered milk, rice and so on. There are some items available on the black market but they are double the regular price. The government stopped the import of fertiliser and pesticides, which means farmers are suffering. We are unable to grow rice on our farm at this time.

Thank God that our children's home still has a small supply of rice.

We currently have 22 girls and 16 boys in the children's home. Our most recent additions to the homes are two girls aged eight and 14; neither of them have been to school before.

Please continue to keep all of the girls, boys and staff in your prayers. Please also pray for the overall situation in Sri Lanka. We are believing for things to improve and for a sense of normalcy to return to the nation.

We are experiencing colder changes in our weather now that we are in fall (autumn) heading into winter.

Omega the boys and I are doing well and are keeping healthy and strong by the grace of God. We appreciate everyone's prayers. In September we were blessed with an opportunity to go white water rafting on one of the rivers here in South Carolina. It was a great family time out.

In September we held our missions fundraiser yard sale. People have been giving things to us to sell for the fundraiser. It has been a blessing.

The family of God here is doing well. A daughter of one of our congregation members has been coming along more often. She brought her boyfriend along for us to meet and she has been regularly seeking counsel from Omega who is speaking into her life.

One of our congregation families had their son in hospital for a heart valve operation and some other medical needs. We praise God that the son's operation was a success and he is doing well.

Early in September we had a BBQ for the family of God we held out the front of the church. The weather was perfect. Everyone really enjoyed the BBQ and fellowship.

For our Bible study, which we have on Wednesday nights, we are doing the 40 Days in the Word Bible study. It is very

challenging, insightful and helpful. It is also refreshing.

One Sunday in October we had Pastors' Appreciation Day. It was a real blessing, especially when people got up and voluntarily offered appreciation for Pr Kaye.

I had a used washing machine and dryer given to me recently which was a blessing. I had been talking about having a washing machine and dryer in the small kitchen area on the bottom section of the church and they were provided. Praise God.

Recently we had a lady come to one of our Wednesday night meetings. Little did we know that this would lead us to operate in the mercy ministry some weeks later. The lady eventually needed a safe place to stay and help to get to her son who lives in Michigan, which is about 13 hours drive

from us. By the grace of God we were able to help this lady with some temporary accommodation. We were also able to provide transport for her and help get her to a bus in a city about 1 hour and 40 minutes away.

This experience was a real challenge for us and I believe a test from God for us. By God's grace we were able to do something to help the lady who was in urgent need. Praise God.

During what they call Oktoberfest here, one of our congregation members, Rose Lorenzen, was able to set up a stall in the street. She joined other street sellers and had an opportunity to sell her knitting and other handmade items

I was blessed when she asked to display a small advertisement for the church at her stall. Not only was she able to promote the church, but she also made it known that we would be having a guest speaker coming on Sunday 31st October. Dr Stan DeKoven will be joining us here with a team of people.
