
We gather every Sunday in our three locations, as people of all ages and from all walks of life, to celebrate God and to experience a powerful message, and we enjoy a time of worship together.



MISSIONS GIVING

As of August 2021, TCCFC is now giving to missions. What an awesome initiative, especially since missions is not what we do. it is who we are!

A big thank you to everyone who generously gives towards the ministries TCCFC is now supporting. Your support and generosity is very much appreciated.

TCCFC will be supporting two very worthwhile children's ministries in Sri Lanka: Bethel Children's Home and Door of Hope Preschool.

Bethel Children's Home

TCCFC commits \$200 per month

Bethel Children's Home have been in operation since 1998 when the first home opened with 11 girls. Since then, two new homes have been built to house more girls on the same property and an additional property was also purchased to build a new home for boys.

All of the children in the homes have been affected by the war and civil unrest in Sri Lanka: displaced, physiologically affected, discriminated against.

The homes have government permission to care for up to 40 children. They maintain a family-like environment by ensuring a high level of individual care. The homes ensure all children are sent to primary and secondary schools within the community, assures all medical and healthcare needs are met, provides all subsistence needs (i.e. food, clothing, shelter, water, sanitation, recreation etc.), and commits to continually support their overall physical, emotional, mental and intellectual development.

TCCFC sponsors two of the children within the home, one boy (Nithusan) and one girl (Saruja). Both of these children are pictured above

Door of Hope Preschool

TCCFC commits \$100 per month

Door of Hope Preschool has been in operation for a number of years now and is located in Vavuniya in the north of Sri Lanka. It is predominantly made up of Tamil speaking children.

We currently have 12 students enrolled with two teachers, however, throughout the COVID-19 pandemic the preschool is continually going in and out of lockdown, along with the rest of Sri Lanka.

TENNANT CREEK TRIP REPORT

I recently visited Tennant Creek and all the mob at Tennant Creek Christian Family Church. I must admit I really enjoyed the weather being in the mid-30s after a number of months of cooler weather in Adelaide.

I was very encouraged with how the church is going since Pr Mike and Lorraine Baker relocated back to South Australia. They have left behind a huge hole after so many years of faithful and fruitful service at TCCFC

Our leadership team have stepped up under Morris' leadership. Our local eldership of Morris and Richard have been tremendous in coordinating the church activities and following up folk where necessary. They have been greatly supported by Pr Edward and Josephine, as well as Andrew and Miriam.

I trust everyone has enjoyed the recent 40 Days in the Word teaching series. I was encouraged by the many testimonies of folk being blessed through this series.

We are still looking at securing a shop in the main street to run our Food Relief Ministry. We are in negotiations with the Real Estate and owners of the previous dance studio in the main street. See the photo at the bottom left of the next page. Hopefully this will become available and at the right price so we can commence the shop in November.

Also on the following page are photos of food parcels that we made up and are ready to go to the remote community of Rockhampton Downs. Pr Edward will visit and pass on the parcels.

We are wanting to visit remote communities in the Barkly Region more and more, and to deliver food parcels, whilst at the same time encouraging the folk through prayer and the Word.

Pr Edward ripped up the old floor boards in the annex of Pr Mike and Lorraine's trailer in readiness to put in a new floor. This annex will be used for our older children on Sunday mornings and youth on Friday nights.

We have outgrown our children's room adjacent to the sound room. We are looking forward in the very near future to having toddlers in this room and the older primary aged children out in the annex on Sunday mornings.

Over the next little while we are investigating how to upgrade our multimedia facility so we can live stream our services. We had quite of a number of outside folk that tuned in to watch our services when we were able to Facetime. We wish to upgrade this area so it can be used as a vital outreach ministry from TCCFC.

I just want to thank everyone for their continued support, service and heart towards what we are doing at TCCFC in reaching Tennant Creek and the wider Barkly Region for the Lord.

May the Lord continue to bless you all.

CONNECT GROUP ARTICLE

Welcome to the October edition of connect groups.

We must lift each other up!

We should keep on encouraging each other to be thoughtful and to do helpful things. Some people have given up the habit of meeting for worship, but we must not do that. We should keep on encouraging each other, especially since you know that the day of the Lord's coming is getting closer (Hebrews 10:24-25).

The Bible has a lot to say on the subject of authentic community and fellowship. These are key components to making the church a thriving, unified body of believers rather than just a bunch of people meeting together.

I remember the story of Pr Charles Spurgeon who once visited a man who had not attended his church for some time. The man said he was still a Christian but didn't think he needed to go to church. Without saying a word, Pr Charles took the tongs from the fireplace and removed one coal, setting it in the corner of the fireplace away from the others. It soon went out. The man got the message: the coals in a fire need each other to stay hot, and Christians need the fellowship of other Christians and the ministry of the Word to keep them spiritually 'hot'!

I sincerely believe that authentic community is not just a great idea. It is exactly what God has called us to experience in ever increasing reality knowing the Lord's coming is closer than ever before. We are being formed and fashioned for what we will be enjoying throughout eternity, which is authentic community.

Bethel Children's Homes

Our homes have been in operation since 1998 when the first home opened with 11 girls. Since then two new homes have been built to house more girls on the same property. A property was also purchased to build a new home for boys. All of the children in the homes have been affected in some way by the war and civil unrest in Sri Lanka: displaced, physiologically affected, discriminated against.

The homes have government permission to care for up to 40 children. They maintain a family-like environment by ensuring a high level of individual care. The homes ensure all children are sent to primary and secondary schools within the community,

assures all medical and healthcare needs are met, provides all subsistence needs (i.e. food, clothing, shelter, water, sanitation, recreation etc.), and commits to continually support their overall physical, emotional, mental and intellectual development.

ACC and TCCFC provides financial and management support for the children and staff within the homes. ACC sponsors four children - Angel, Thinu, Jonathan and George. TCCFC sponsors two children - Saruja and Nithusan.

Prayer Points:

- Pray for all of our children during this uncertain time. Believe for all our new children to settle in effectively.


