Why do we Celebrate Christmas?

How can a baby born 2000 plus years ago on the other side of the world cause us to grind to a halt for a day on the 25th December?

It's because He was no ordinary baby!

John 3:16a (tlb) God loved the world so much that He gave His only Son...

Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a child is born...

But He was no ordinary child.

Jesus went from a crib to the cross to become our Saviour, providing us forgiveness and an eternal future.

OUR PAST IS BE FORGIVEN.

Romans 3:23-24 (tlb) All of us have sinned yet now God declares us `not guilty' of offending Him 'if' we trust in Christ who freely takes away our sin.

- God's forgiveness is **INSTANT.**
- God's forgiveness is **UNDESERVED.**
- God's forgiveness is **COMPLETE**.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

Isaiah 43:25 (nlt) I alone will blot out your sins for My own sake and will never think of them again.

What God forgets; we should forget too!

If anyone is in Christ, he becomes a new person altogether; the past is finished and gone, everything becomes fresh and new. 2 Corinthians 5:17 (ph)

At Christmas time, probably the most used word we hear is "gift".

God has two gifts for us, and they are wrapped up in one big gift - Jesus Christ!

• God's gift of **FORGIVENESS**.

Ephesians 1:4-7 (gnb) Let us praise God for the free gift He gave us in His Son ... we are set free, our sins are forgiven."

• God's gift of **ETERNAL LIFE**.

Romans 6:23 The gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
