

Title: ***Jesus, the Source of our Total Supply***

Text: John 2:1-11

What is the most unusual wedding you've been to? Inviting a dignitary or a well-known person somehow would lift the standard and could make the event so special.

There was one wedding that was mentioned in the Bible, where Jesus was invited and what He did was nothing short of a miracle.

The first miracle that Jesus made was during the wedding.

God honours relationship!

This applies to a marriage relationship, family, relatives, amongst friends, amongst business partners and companies.

When we learn to love and honour God in our lives, we then learn to value relationship, we learn to value people.

Key principles to live by...

1. Invite Jesus – *Jesus knows your every need!*

Now both Jesus and His disciples were invited to the wedding. (John 2:2)

When the couple were thinking of whom to invite, they thought of inviting Jesus!

Nobody knew what Jesus could until a need arose.

Jesus was there because He knew there would be a need that only He could meet, and the result was nothing short of a miracle.

What does it mean to us? We should not short-change our life. We should not be living on our own.

Invite Jesus, He knows your every need!

John 14:6 – *I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.*

Jesus alone can give purpose and meaning to our life.

Ex. Our phone is useless and purposeless without any connection. So is life. If you are not connected to the life source, you may have so much and yet your life is empty and has no meaning. You have everything but you feel void.

2. Trust in His timing. *Jesus knows when you really need it!*

⁴ *Jesus said to her, “Woman, what does your concern have to do with Me? My hour has not yet come.” (John 2:4)*

God ordains the time and season for everything.

A person who truly believes God also believes in His timing.

Read Romans 8:28; Isaiah 40:31; Lamentation 3:25-26; Psalm 27:14

Timing is something that God is very mindful of according to Scripture. God knows the perfect time when to unfold His promises in our lives.

Everything God has promised comes in His timing!

When **waiting on God's timing**, it can take weeks and sometimes months or even years before we receive the promise.

Galatians 6:9 – *And let us not be weary in well doing for in due season we shall reap if we faint not.*

Keep believing that God knows what is best for us and that He will answer our prayers in His own perfect time.

Keep believing on the promises of God for us which are all “Yes” and “Amen” in Christ (**2 Cor. 1:20**)

Keep fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith. (**Heb. 12:2**)

Everything you need, God has already provided, and He will do it in His own time.

2 Peter 1:3 – *God has given us all things we need pertaining to this life and godliness.*

Don't take matters in your own hands, learn to trust in His timing.

Ex. Abraham and Sarah took matters into their own hands. (Read **Genesis 16:1-6**).

Instead of trusting God's timing, he compromised and thought of helping God.

This resulted to numerous complications:

- **tension** between Abraham and Sarah
- **competition** between Sarah and Hagar
- **religious conflict** we experience to this very day and the **ongoing conflict** between the nation of Israel and the Arab countries

God ordains the time and season for everything you need. Always trust in His timing.

3. Do whatever Jesus tells you to do. *He knows what He is doing!*

⁵ *His mother said to the servants, “Whatever He says to you, do it.” (John 2:5)*

Whatever Jesus tells you to do, JUST DO IT.

Faith is not just something we believe; faith is something we do.

James 2:17 – *Faith without works is dead.*

Christian life is not the accumulation of knowledge, but the application of knowledge.

Obedience is greater than sacrifice.

God always requires whole-hearted obedience on our part. Partial obedience is not obedience at all!

If Jesus is not Lord of all, He is not Lord of all.

Obedience brings definite results...

a. You will eat the best of the land.

Isaiah 1:19 (AMP) – *If you are willing and obedient, you will eat the best of the land.*

b. You will experience the Holy Spirit.

Acts 5:32 – *We are witnesses of these things, and so the Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey Him.*

We need to keep obeying God. Don't complain about it, don't rationalise about it, just do it!

In our text for today, when the servants obeyed Jesus, miracle happened.

¹⁰ *And he said to him, "...You have kept the good wine until now!"*¹¹ *This beginning of signs Jesus did... and manifested His glory... (John 2:10)*

Conclusion:

Is Jesus part of your life?

Invite Jesus. Let Him be part of your life and in all your decisions and experience the difference.

How could Jesus bring celebration back into your life today?

Maybe you are waiting for God's answer and it is taking a while. Remember, the one who made the promise is faithful! Everything God has promised you comes in His timing. Trust Him completely!
