COVID OBSERVATIONS

- A general attitude of 'me, my rights and self'.
 A lack of enthusiasm for what the Lord is passionate for: reaching the lost.
- People swinging away from Biblical TRUTH to people's opinions and finding similar views online to reinforce those opinions.
- People isolating and out of fellowship because of fear, Govt restrictions, being out of the routine and the habit of meeting together -Church.
- 4. People disconnected and this is reflected in attendance, attitude, giving and serving.

LEADING OUT OF COVID BY REBOOTING THE DISCIPLESHIP PROCESS

ACC Vision (why we exist)

ACC Mission (what we do)

- Empower people for life change (making disciples)

Outworking these six commitments through the...

ACC Ministry Strategy (how we do it)

ENGAGE people WITH Jesus.

- To live a devoted lifestyle that passionately follows and obeys Jesus.

John 14:21 (erv) Those who really love me are the ones who not only know my commands but also obey them. My Father will love such people, and I will love them. I will make myself known to them."

Matthew 10:38 (amp) And he who does not take his cross [expressing a willingness to endure whatever may come] and follow Me [believing in Me, conforming to My example in living and, if need be, suffering or perhaps dying because of faith in Me] is not worthy of Me.

- To intentionally pursue the lost with the Gospel of Jesus.

Matthew 28:19-20a (*niv*) Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you...

ESTABLISH people INTO their faith.

- To strengthen Biblical foundations to build our lives upon.

2 Timothy 3:16-17 (erv) All Scripture is given by God. And all Scripture is useful for teaching and for showing people what is wrong in their lives. It is useful for correcting faults and teaching the right way to live. ¹⁷ Using the Scriptures, those who serve God will be prepared and will have everything they need to do every good work.

Psalms 25:4-5 (gnb) Teach me your ways, O Lord; make them known to me. ⁵ Teach me to live according to your truth, for you are my God, who saves me. I always trust in you.

- To deepen our connection with one another to experience authentic Christian community.

Ecclesiastes 4:12 (*erv*) An enemy might be able to defeat one person, but two people can stand back-to-back to defend each other. And three people are even stronger. They are like a rope that has three parts wrapped together - it is very hard to break.

Hebrews 10:24-25a (amp) let us consider [thoughtfully] how we may encourage one another to love and to do good deeds, ²⁵ not forsaking our meeting together [as believers for worship and instruction], as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another...; (see also Acts 2:42-47)

EQUIP people FOR service.

- To discover our spiritual gifts, abilities and aligning them with our heart desires to serve.

Ephesians 2:10 (amp) For we are His workmanship [His own master work, a work of art], created in Christ Jesus [reborn from above - spiritually transformed, renewed,

ready to be used] for good works, which God prepared [for us] beforehand [taking paths which He set], so that we would walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us].

EMPOWER people TO serve.

- To reprioritise our lifestyles to serve Jesus in the local church, community and world.

1 Peter 4:10 (amp) Just as each one of you has received a special gift [a spiritual talent, an ability graciously given by God], employ it in serving one another as [is appropriate for] good stewards of God's multi-faceted grace [faithfully using the diverse, varied gifts and abilities granted to Christians by God's unmerited favor].

EQUIP TRAINING COLLEGE
