JESUS IS GOD'S GIFT TO US

The message of Christmas is that we matter to God so much that He sent His Son Jesus Christ to earth to reveal how much we matter to Him.

Luke 2:10-11;14 (ncv) The angel said, "Don't be afraid! I bring you the most joyful news ever announced, and it is for everyone! Today your Savior was born... He is Christ, the Lord 14: Give glory to God in heaven, and on earth let there be peace among the people who please God."

GOD'S GIFT OF JOY

John 3:17 (tlb) God did not send His Son into the world to condemn it, but to save it.

Jesus didn't come to put us down - He came to lift us up!

GOD'S GIFT OF PEACE

"Let there be peace among the people."

God wants us to have good relationships with other people, not just with Him.

Christmas can be a time to reflect. A time to reconcile, to break down barriers, and to build bridges, restoring relationships that have been broken and damaged.

Once we've got peace *with* God, then we get the peace *of* God in our life.

Once we've got the peace of God then we can have peace with other people.

2 Corinthians 5:18 God reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation.

2 Corinthians 9:15 Thanks be to God for His gift. It's too wonderful for words.

I urge you this Christmas to receive the gift God's given us and receive Him into your life. It's simple. All you do is ask Him!
