Hebrews 12:2 (New Life Version) "Let us keep looking to Jesus. Our faith comes from Him and He is the One who makes it perfect. He did not give up when He had to suffer shame and die on a cross. He knew of the joy that would be his later. Now He is sitting at the right side of God."

1. JESUS IS OUR ALL IN ALL

He is the One who has made it possible for us to know God.

John 14:6 NIV

He is the One who has made the way open for you and me to approach God's throne, with CONFIDENCE.

Hebrews 4:14-16 NIV

We love because he first loved us - 1 John 4:19 NIV

Ephesians 3:17b-19; Romans 8:38-39 NIV

2. **JESUS INSPIRES US**

3. **JESUS SUSTAINS US**

Titus 3:3-5a NIV

Our salvation came as we responded to his love. He initiated it.

And he continues that work in us - Philippians 1:6 NIV

Ephesians 1:13-14 NIV

He sustains us. He carries us. He reminds us of God's truth. He encourages us. He comforts us. He gives us eyes to see what is right and true.
