- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. (nkjv)
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if anyone is in Christ [that is, grafted in, joined to Him by faith in Him as Saviour], he is a new creature [reborn and renewed by the Holy Spirit]; the old things [the previous moral and spiritual condition] have passed away. Behold, new things have come [because spiritual awakening brings a new life].

The greatest truth for the sinner is the Gospel.

- Salvation, Water Baptism, Baptism in the Holy Spirit, etc.

The greatest truth for the believer is the New Creation


- The revelation of us In Christ and Christ In us.

ALL THINGS NEW

Body - Soul - Spirit

We are tri-partite beings.

- Body: 5 natural senses (Touch, taste, smell, see, hear)
- Soul: Will, mind, emotions, etc
- **Spirit:** Knowing/intuition, conscience, communion/fellowship, etc.



GOD DOES NOT REPAIR OR RENOVATE US.

Jesus made a promise.

John 15:5 I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.

Romans 5:18 Therefore, as through one man's offense judgment came to all men, resulting in condemnation, even so through one Man's righteous act the free gift came to all men, resulting in justification of life.

 The destination of the old creation is condemnation.

1 Corinthians 15:22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive.

We are either in Adam or in Christ!

This is all about the 'Real Person.'

The 'Holy of Holies' – the inner, eternal being.

IN CHRIST

The believer lives 'In Christ.'

In Christ or In Christ Jesus or In Him (Or similar) is found 164 times.

Ephesians 1:7 In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace.

Colossians 1:13-14 He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

2 Corinthians 5:21 God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

He became what we were in order that we might become what He is.

John 5:25; John 1:13; Colossians 2:10; Romans 8:37; 2 Corinthians 2:14.

CHRIST IN ME

The resurrection life of Jesus Christ indwells the Believer.

Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead **dwells in you**, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

Colossians 1:27 To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the glorious riches of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

1 Peter 1:23 Having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever,

1 John 4:4 You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because **He who is in you** is greater than he who is in the world.

 Our new birth is by the incorruptible seed of God's living Word. 1 John 4:15 Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, God abides in him, and he in God.

Titus 3:5-6; Romans 8:10; Ephesians 2:1-5; Ephesians 3:16-21.
