Overcoming the Flesh

To display the fruits of the spirits in our lives, we must be living and aiming to live through God's spirit, and not through our own fleshly desires.

Romans 8:9-12

The same power that raised Jesus from the dead, is the same spirit that gives life to our sinful and human bodies.

The bible is very clear. If you live by the flesh, you will die (spiritually), if you live by the spirit, you will live.

Because we have committed our lives to him, it's our responsibility to live in the spirit.

Romans 8:37, 1 Corinthians 10:13

With Christ, we have power over every authority. We can live in the spirit and live in the truth of our authority in Christ and our identity in him.

In *Matthew 6*, Jesus talks about how we should navigate fasting. When he begins the topic, he says "when" you fast... not "if", but "when."

When we fast, we decrease our reliance on our fleshly appetite and naturally start to rely on the spirit within our lives. We can hear God clearer, listen to his voice and see things from his perspective.

"Heal my heart and make it clean, open up my eyes to the things unseen, show me how to love like you have loved me, break my heart for what breaks yours, everything I am, for your kingdom's cause, as I walk from earth into eternity"

In every part of our lives, we need to allow the holy spirit the room to work in our lives. A simple prayer/song like this is important.

To operate in the fruits of the spirit, we need to live in the spirit, and not the flesh.
