THE UNITY OF THE SPIRIT

Ephesians 4:1-6 I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called, ² with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, ³ endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. ⁴ There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling; ⁵ one Lord, one faith, one baptism; ⁶ one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.

John 17:20-23..... that they all may be one, as You,; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me. ²², that they may be one just as We are one: ²³ I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me.

1. Paul make a clear call to all believers

- To 'walk worthy'
- · This is how we are to walk live, think, behave

2. What is Unity of the Spirit?

It is not a union or uniformity

It is: "To believe, think, act and behave as those whose faith in the Lord Jesus Christ results in them to living a life of harmony, love, respect, forgiveness, serving, patience and Christlikeness - that reflects the person of Jesus Christ to one-another and to the world in which we live"

3. What destroys the Unity of the Spirit?

 Gossip, Criticism, Back-biting, Pride, Little foxes, White-anting, Unforgiveness.

Song of Solomon 2:15 Catch us the foxes, The little foxes that spoil the vines, for our vines have tender grapes.

Proverbs 11:13 A gossip betrays a confidence, but a trustworthy person keeps a secret.

Proverbs 16:28 A perverse person stirs up conflict, and a gossip separates close friends.

Proverbs 17:9 Whoever would foster love covers over an offence, but whoever repeats the matter separates close friends.

2 Corinthians 12:20 For I am afraid that when I come I may not find you as I want you to be, and you may not find me as you want me to be. I fear that there may be discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, slander, gossip, arrogance and disorder.

James 4:11 Brothers and sisters, do not slander one another. Anyone who speaks against a brother or sister or judges them speaks against the law and judges it. When you judge the law, you are not keeping it, but sitting in judgment on it.

Matthew 7:1-5 Do not judge, or you too will be judged. ² For in the same way as you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you. ³ 'Why do you look at the speck of sawdust in your

brother's eye and pay no attention to the plank in your own eye? ⁴ How can you say to your brother, "Let me take the speck out of your eye," when all the time there is a plank in your own eye? ⁵ You hypocrite, first take the plank out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye.

Galatians 5:15 If you bite and devour each other, watch out or you will be destroyed by each other.

My mother taught me: "If you can't say anything nice about someone, don't say anything at all!"

Factions and Cliques

1 Corinthians 3:1-9 Brothers and sisters,Are you not acting like mere humans? ⁴ For when one says, 'I follow Paul,' and another, 'I follow Apollos,' are you not mere human beings? ⁵ What, after all, is Apollos? And what is Paul? Only servants, through whom you came to believe – as the Lord has assigned to each his task. ⁶ I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God has been making it grow. ⁷ So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow....; you are God's field, God's building.

4. How do we keep the Unity of the Spirit?

- Not by rules
 - Laws, rules, commandments, etc
- Not by the 'lowest common denominator'
 - Compromise and negotiation

5. Unity of the Spirit is based on seven foundations:

Ephesians 4:4-. There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling; ⁵ one Lord, one faith, one baptism; ⁶ one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.

One body

- We love and Honour the church that Jesus loves

One Spirit

- The Holy Spirit of God who empowers us - BHS

One hope

- We share a wonderful hope of the resurrection and heaven

One Lord

- We acknowledge our only Lord, Saviour and King

One faith

Our faith in Christ alone for salvation and eternal life

One baptism

 Our identification with Christ and separation from our former life

One God

 We believe in one true and living God, Creator,
Commander and Supreme Ruler – who is above all, through all and in you all

6. Attributes of unity

Ephesians 4:1-3 I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called, ² with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, ³ endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Humility

- Lowliness being humble and unimportant
- We do not provoke or are easily provoked
- We do not offend or are easily offended

Repentance

- Being quick to repent and ask forgiveness

Forgiveness

- An ongoing mindset of forgiveness

Respect

- Honoring and esteeming each other

Gentleness

- Exhibiting kindness, grace and gentleness

Longsuffering

- Patience with each other
- Not seeking revenge

Bearing with one-another in love

- Bearing one another's shortcomings

The bond of peace

United to strengthen each other for a common purpose

Serving one-another

Matthew 20:28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."
