### Title: But I Have Come...

#### **Text: John 10:10**

"The thief comes only to steal, to kill, and to destroy; but I have come that they may have life and have it more abundantly."

### The enemy's mission is clear:

- . Steal your peace and joy
- . Kill the life God intended for you
- Destroy your calling and destiny

**God's promise:** *Jeremiah 1:5; Jeremiah 29:11 – God has a plan for your life.* 

# **Abundant Life: More Than Problem-Free Living**Jesus didn't just come to give life – He came to give **abundant life**:

- A life full of God's presence
- Daily awareness of His guidance, comfort, and power
- . Transformation from the inside out

### What living full of God's presence looks like:

- . Peace replaces fear
- . Purpose becomes clear
- . Love overflows
- . Strength is renewed

### **Biblical foundation:**

- Exodus 33:14–15 God's presence brings rest
- Psalm 16:11 Fullness of joy in God's presence
- Matthew 28:20 Jesus promises to be with us always

Living a Spirit-filled life doesn't mean **perfection** – it means **connection**. Peace, purpose, and power flow from daily fellowship with Him.

# **The Gospel:** The good news of Jesus Christ:

- . He is God's Son
- . He died for our sins
- . He rose again
- Through faith, we receive forgiveness, reconciliation, abundant and eternal life

# The Gospel Illustrated: Tetelestai – *It Is Finished*

### **Story of the King and the Princess:**

- . A thief stole from the king's treasury
- . The thief turned out to be the king's daughter
- . The king took the punishment upon himself

This is the Gospel: Jesus took the punishment for our sins.

When Jesus cried, "It is finished," He declared three things:

# Debt fully paid (Business)

- Colossians 2:14 Jesus cancelled our sin debt
- Application: Live free from guilt; salvation is a gift, not earned

## 2. Sentence fully served (Courtroom)

Romans 8:1 – No condemnation for those in Christ Application: Christ bore the penalty for us; we are justified

# 3. Battle fully won (Battlefield)

- 1 Corinthians 15:57 Victory through the Lord
- Application: Fight from victory, not for it;
  daily struggles are skirmishes

Tetelestai – *It is finished*. Your debt is fully paid, your sentence fully served, your battle completely won.

### **Conclusion & Challenge**

Jesus didn't come to make life bearable; He came to make it **abundant**:

- . Peace the world cannot take
- . Joy circumstances cannot shake
- . Purpose that suffering cannot destroy

The thief may come – but Jesus has come:

- . To restore
- . To give life

. To declare victory

### **Challenge:**

If you haven't fully surrendered to Christ, do so now:

"Jesus, I give You ownership of my life. I receive Your life, forgiveness, and victory. Fill me with Your presence."

- If you are already a follower of Christ, live intentionally in His presence:
  - Let the Spirit guide your decisions
  - Let Him shape your character
  - Let Him flow through your relationships

**Remember:** Abundant life isn't a someday promise – it is available **today**.
